III. DISCUSSION / APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #25-35 – FY'26 BUDGET ADOPTION FOR GENERAL FUND

Mayor Weaver asked for a motion to approve Resolution #25-35 – FY'26 Budget Adoption for General Fund. A motion was made by Councilmember McLeod, seconded by Councilmember Nobles and it passed unanimously.

IV. DISCUSSION / APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #25-36 – FY'26 BUDGET ADOPTION FOR CONFISCATED ASSETS FUND

Mayor Weaver asked for a motion to approve Resolution #25-36 – FY'26 Budget Adoption for Confiscated Assets Fund. A motion was made by Councilmember Miller, seconded by Councilmember McLeod and it passed unanimously.

V. DISCUSSION / APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #25-37 – FY'26 BUDGET ADOPTION FOR GRANT FUND

Mayor Weaver asked for a motion to approve Resolution #25-37 – FY'26 Budget Adoption for Grant Fund. A motion was made by Councilmember Nobles, seconded by Councilmember Miller and it passed unanimously.

VI. DISCUSSION / APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #25-38 – FY'26 BUDGET ADOPTION FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUND

Mayor Weaver asked for a motion to approve Resolution #25-38 – FY'26 Budget Adoption for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Fund. A motion was made by Councilmember Nobles, seconded by Councilmember McLeod and it passed unanimously.

VII. DISCUSSION / APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #25-39 – FY'26 BUDGET ADOPTION FOR HOTEL MOTEL EXCISE TAX FUND

Mayor Weaver asked for a motion to approve Resolution #25-39 – FY'26 Budget Adoption for Hotel Motel Excise Tax Fund. A motion was made by Councilmember Miller, seconded by Councilmember Nobles and it passed unanimously.

VIII. DISCUSSION / APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #25-40 – FY'26 BUDGET ADOPTION FOR SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX (SPLOST) FUND

Mayor Weaver asked for a motion to approve Resolution #25-40 – FY'26 Budget Adoption for Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) Fund. A motion was made by Councilmember McLeod, seconded by Councilmember Miller and it passed unanimously.

IX. DISCUSSION / APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #25-41 – FY'26 BUDGET ADOPTION FOR TRANSPORTATION SPECIAL DISTRICT LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX (T-SPLOST) FUND

Mayor Weaver asked for a motion to approve Resolution #25-41 – FY'26 Budget Adoption for Transportation Special District Local Option Sales Tax Fund. A motion was made by Councilmember Miller, seconded by Councilmember McLeod and it passed unanimously.

X. DISCUSSION / APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #25-42 – FY'25 BUDGET ADOPTION FOR WATER / SEWER FUND

Mayor Weaver asked for a motion to approve Resolution #25-42 – FY'26 Budget Adoption for Water Sewer Fund. A motion was made by Councilmember Nobles, seconded by Councilmember McLeod and it passed unanimously.

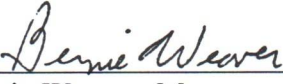

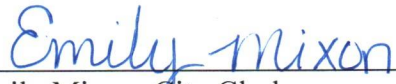
XIII. ADJOURN
